SECONDARY SCHOOL APPLICATIONS

This week all Year 6 children have been sent home with a letter from Devon County Council. The letter contains important information, including a unique identifying number, on how to apply for your child's secondary school place. The application process is open from 1st September, closing on 31st October. Please be aware that applications received by Devon County after the closing date could result in your child not receiving a place at your preferred school. YEAR 3 SCHOOL LUNCHES
