BOOK FAIR

30 HOUR FUNDING AND TAX FREE CHILDCARE

The process is apparently very simple and reminders will be sent to those families direct from HMRC 4 weeks, and again 2 weeks, before expiry. Please note that those reminders go direct to the individual childcare service account (not by e-mail or text) so families will need to log in to check their account.
