## SCHOOL MEALS AND PUPIL PREMIUM

A reminder that all Infant children (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) are eligible for universal free school meals. We hope that your Early Years children and those moving on to the Juniors in September will continue to take up our freshly prepared meals. The cost is still £2.30 per meal for these.

We would also encourage eligible families to apply for Pupil Premium. If awarded, this would provide free school meals for Junior age children, and also enable us to offer reductions in costs of school trips/clubs etc. It is really worth applying, even if your child currently gets Infant fee meals.

DCC have asked us to give the link to a source of cheaper/free food that families eligible for free school meals who are finding things difficult during the Summer holidays.
