When I was at school I was really under confident and although I knew I loved music and wanted to pursue it as a career, I could have really done with someone like me to speak to, one to one to gain some knowledge on the industry and everything around it. By that I don't mean someone telling me to go on a reality tv show and all my wishes will be granted, I mean someone to teach me to have self discipline, to work hard, the importance in education and where it can get you.

My goal is to encourage children to take part in music, as it's a social tool as they get older, it's great for your mental health as a way to express yourself and inspire the children to be creative...when I was at primary school, only 10 years ago.. I didn't have an iPad, or a phone.. I had a guitar and a notebook...I want children to realise music can be 'cool' and it's been really lovely to see not only girls, but boys getting up and singing with me.
