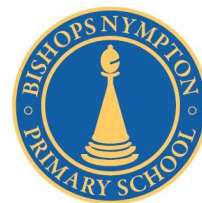

Attached to this newsletter is a letter from the headteacher, with an update on the current funding position affecting many schools nationally including ours.

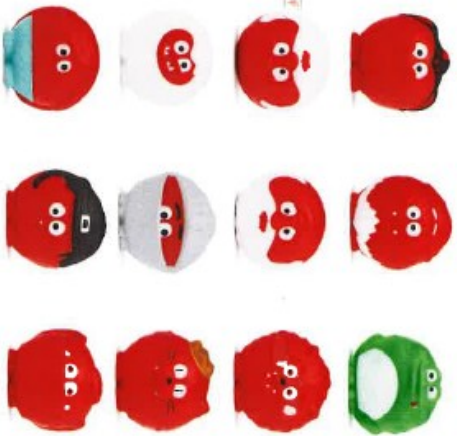
