PE/OUTDOOR LEARNING

PE and Outdoor Learning for both classes are on Monday Please can you make sure your child has all the appropriate kit in school for these lessons? For outdoor learning this should be

- Long sleeve tops/shirts for both Winter and Summer and a warmer top when colder
- Bottoms that cover the whole leg - Trousers/legging/track suit bottoms etc.
- Footwear - wellies/boots etc. when outside is wet and muddy and trainers/boots etc. when it is drier and warmer.
- Hats, gloves and scarves are useful when it is colder.

In addition there is a PE session on Friday when children will need their kit in school.

SCHOOL DINNERS

A reminder that school lunches are FREE for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. The meals are freshly prepared each day and fully nutritionally balanced. 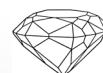
