South Molton Scrapstore is a community, not for profit organisation. We ask for a £2 donation to cover the costs of each session.

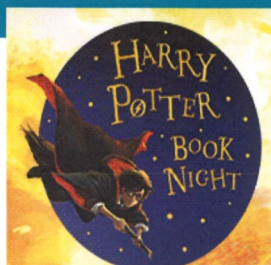
